- 1830 Dr. Charles Taylor Pepper born in Montgomery Co. VA.
- 1855 Dr. C.T. Pepper received his medical degree from the University of Virginia.
- 1858 Dr. C.T. Pepper married Isabella McDowell Howe.
- 1862 Dr. C.T. Pepper and family at Bristol, VA. Stationed at Emory & Henry Hospital as a surgeon for the Confederate Army.
- 1879 Dr. C.T. Pepper moved to Rural Retreat, VA.
- 1895 Elder in Presbyterian Church and President of the Ausburg Bank.
- 1903 Dr. Charles Taylor Pepper and his wife die. Both are buried along with their sons at Mountain View Cemetery in Rural Retreat, VA.
